Legislative Changes to Wineries Effective October 1, 2023

With the passage of Nevada Senate Bill 259, effective October 1, 2023, NRS 597.240 has been amended to allow wineries issued licenses on or after October 1, 2015, as long as 25% or more of the wine produced, blended or aged from fruit grown or honey produced in Nevada the ability to sell at retail or serve by the glass on its premises *and one other location*, wine produced, blended or aged by the winery.

If less than 25 percent of the wine produced, blended or aged by the winery is produced blended or aged from fruit grown or honey produced in this state the ability to sell at retail or serve by the glass on its premises *and one other location*, not more than 2000 cases of wine produced, blended or aged at the winery *and not more 150 barrels of cider produced by the winery* per calendar year.
